## **FLAKY REIKI?**

Is it **really** flaky? Or is it more sinister? Perhaps there is some kind of hocus pocus involved? Well, I know that many of you still think so! Hello skeptics — this article is written especially for you! Let me try to put this into perspective to allay your fears and let you know that Reiki is for the 'good' guys and that there is nothing to be concerned about.


I have been practicing Reiki since 1988. I have seen many changes in attitude towards this healing modality during that period but I still find reservation, if not outright rejection, from some people. Usually this point of view is centred around a religious dogma – dogma as in system of belief.

My puzzlement is that if it is acceptable to take a pill or potion to change the chemical imbalances in the body, and a pill is composed of particles which are simply forms of energy, then why would it be so difficult to step into understanding that energy can work **directly** on the human system and bypass the use of chemicals? Humans have been doing it for centuries.

During that time, people who used the energy and those who experienced the benefits simply accepted the method and the end results. As an example, acupuncture has been a mainstay in this approach. Today we are so much more equipped to explain the process through the use of sophisticated equipment. For instance, brain waves are measurable and even the heart's electrical activity can be monitored.

The human energy field also exists and can be measured. It ties in with ancient understandings that the spinal cord holds seven major energy cumulative centres and these are known as 'chakras' or wheels. I like to think of them as the roundabouts found on the ABC highway! Traffic flows from one point to another and then is re-directed into smaller and smaller arteries until eventually the most remote point in the countryside is reachable by even a simple track. The analogy is that all cells in the body are fed energetically from these seven major centres. However, if there is disruption at Bussa, the effects will be felt as far back Warrens and you will arrive late for dinner, even if you live at North Point!

Our understanding of Reiki is that it operates on a frequency between 0.3 Hz and 30 Hz. This corresponds to the planet's Schumann Resonance. There is much information on the net but Ingrid P. Dickenson in explaining this phenomenon makes the interesting comment that she believes the resonance is "a very

important electromagnetic standing wave, acting as background frequency and influencing biological oscillators within the mammalian brain". This range seems to target all kinds of dis-ease but it has been observed that the frequency between 7-10 Hz is the most common and the most effective.

The practitioner 'tunes' in with this energy by quietening down thoughts and going into Alpha brainwave state (8-12 Hz), which is alert relaxation. By becoming 'one' with the frequency, the practitioner is able to link the earth's energy into the energy field of the client. Generally, the client experiences a very deep relaxation, thereby themselves going into a meditative and receptive state. When this happens, muscles relax, blood flows more freely and, on a physical level, cells are nourished. It is well known that guided visualization and/or meditation is prescribed in most hospitals with cancer wards to alleviate the effects of chemo and radio-therapy. Reiki is a touch therapy but is also equally effective with hands slightly off the body.

The process is safe, no one 'catches' nor transmits anything nasty from either person and the value of touch in healing is well-known. We intuitively tell the little child who has just hurt himself – here, let me kiss it better.

So really the core of the matter – whether getting a prescription from the doctor or having a Reiki treatment – is really the unconditional love which is extended by the practitioner to a stranger. There is no greater force than Love, no matter which disguise it operates under.
